## 1. Installation Complete - What's Next?

Congratulations! PredictIndicators has been installed to your MetaTrader 5 terminal. Your indicators are now ready to use. This guide will walk you through the essential steps to start viewing AI-powered predictions on your charts.

### What Was Installed:

| Component                          | Location in MT5 Navigator      |
|------------------------------------|--------------------------------|

## 2. Enabling WebRequest (Required)

PredictIndicators connects to our AI prediction server to fetch forecast data. You must enable WebRequest in MetaTrader 5 and add our server URL to the allowed list. This is a one-time setup.

IMPORTANT: The indicators will not display predictions until this step is completed.

### Step 1: Open MT5 Options

In MetaTrader 5, go to the menu: Tools → Options (or press Ctrl+O).

### Step 2: Navigate to Expert Advisors Tab

In the Options window, click on the 'Expert Advisors' tab.

### Step 3: Enable WebRequest

Check the box that says 'Allow WebRequest for listed URL'.

### Step 4: Add the PredictIndicators Server URL

---

Click in the URL list area below the checkbox and add the following URL:

```
https://metatrader.predictindicators.ai
```

### Step 5: Click OK

Click OK to save the settings and close the Options window.

*TIP: You only need to do this once. The setting is saved and will persist across MT5 restarts.*

---

## 3. Adding Indicators to a Chart

### Step 1: Open or Restart MetaTrader 5

If MetaTrader 5 was running during installation, close it completely and reopen it. This ensures the new indicators are loaded into the Navigator panel.

### Step 2: Open the Navigator Panel

If the Navigator panel is not visible, press Ctrl+N or go to View → Navigator. The Navigator panel typically appears on the left side of the MT5 window.

### Step 3: Locate PredictIndicators

In the Navigator panel, expand the Indicators section by clicking the + icon. You will see a folder called PredictIndicators containing all installed indicators.

### Step 4: Add an Indicator to Your Chart

Drag any indicator from the Navigator panel onto your chart. Alternatively, double-click the indicator name or right-click and select 'Attach to a chart'.

*TIP: You can add multiple indicators to the same chart. Each indicator will display in its own sub-window below the main price chart.*

## 4. Configuring Your API Key

PredictIndicators uses AI models hosted on our servers to generate predictions. You need a valid API key to access these predictions.

### Step 1: Get Your API Key

Log in to your account at [predictindicators.ai](https://predictindicators.ai) and navigate to your Dashboard. Your API key is displayed in the Account Settings section. Copy this key.

### Step 2: Enter the API Key

When you first add a PredictIndicators indicator to a chart, a settings dialog appears. Paste your API key into the 'API\_Key' or 'License\_Key' input field.

### Step 3: Save as Default (Optional)

---

To avoid entering your API key every time, right-click on the indicator after it's loaded, select 'Properties', and click 'Save' to store your settings as default.

**IMPORTANT:** Keep your API key private. Do not share it with others. Each subscription is licensed to a single user.

---

## 5. Understanding the Display

Each PredictIndicator displays two types of information:

| Element         | Description  |
|-----------------|--|
| Historical Line | The standard indicator calculation based on past price data (typically blue) |
| Prediction Line | AI-generated forecast extending 30 bars into the future (typically green)    |
| Confidence Band | Shaded area showing the prediction confidence range (optional)               |

The prediction line shows where the AI model expects the indicator value to move over the next 30 bars. This can help you anticipate potential trend changes, overbought/oversold conditions, or momentum shifts before they appear on the standard indicator.

### Interpreting the Predictions:

The green prediction line extends from the current bar into the future. Compare it to the historical indicator values to understand where the AI expects the indicator to move. Steep upward or downward slopes suggest stronger expected moves.

## 6. Indicator Reference

| Indicator         | Base Indicator          | What It Predicts            |
|-------------------|-------------------------|-----------------------------|
| AwesomeOscillator | Bill Williams AO        | Future momentum direction   |
| ATR               | Average True Range      | Expected volatility levels  |
| DM                | Directional Movement    | Trend direction changes     |
| MACD              | Moving Average Conv/Div | Momentum & crossover timing |
| Stochastics       | Stochastic Oscillator   | Overbought/oversold levels  |
| StochasticsFast   | Fast Stochastic         | Quick reversal points       |

Each indicator uses the same AI prediction engine trained specifically for that indicator type. The predictions are generated in real-time based on current market data and are updated as new bars form.

---

## 7. Troubleshooting

### Indicators not showing in Navigator

Close MetaTrader 5 completely and restart it. If still not visible, right-click in the Navigator panel and select 'Refresh'. Ensure you installed to the correct MT5 terminal if you have multiple installations.

### 'WebRequest failed' or no predictions showing

This usually means WebRequest is not enabled or the URL is not added. Go to Tools → Options → Expert Advisors tab. Ensure 'Allow WebRequest for listed URL' is checked and the URL <https://metatrader.predictindicators.ai> is in the list.

### 'Invalid API Key' error

Verify your API key is entered correctly with no extra spaces. Check that your subscription is active at [predictindicators.ai](https://predictindicators.ai). Ensure your internet connection is working.

### Prediction line not appearing

The indicator needs to receive data from the prediction server. Check the Experts tab in MT5 (Ctrl+T, then Experts tab) for any error messages. Verify that MT5 is allowed through your firewall and that WebRequest is properly configured.

### Predictions seem delayed

Predictions are fetched when a new bar forms or when you first attach the indicator. If you want to refresh predictions manually, remove the indicator from the chart and re-attach it.
